



BRINGING THE GOSPEL TO UNREACHED PEOPLE

Dear Friend,

In Northern Pakistan, there are many places where the Gospel has never reached. People have never been told that God loves them, or that Christ came to forgive and bring salvation. They are living in deep spiritual darkness.

They are the unreached people. Few are willing to go there.

Pastor Amir and his team travel to places where sharing the Gospel carries great risk. Pakistan's strict blasphemy laws mean that even a false accusation can lead to prison, violence, or even death.

Because the risk is so great, Pastor Amir must be extremely careful and wise.

In his visits, he listens to people's stories. He earns their trust, which opens the door to deeper conversations.

Slowly, conversations turn to spiritual matters. Those who were once hesitant begin opening their hearts. Questions replace suspicion. And soon, an offered Bible is gladly received.

Muslim people who receive the Bible accept and recognize it as something precious.

The team also distributes my father's book, *Tortured for His Faith*, in the Urdu language. Because of the title of the book, it is a wonderful introduction to those still hesitant about reading the Bible. Sharing Dad's powerful testimony of courage, suffering, and faith in Christ introduces an interest in reading the Word of God.

Day by day, through this outreach ministry, God is opening hearts and changing lives in this difficult to reach people in Northern Pakistan.

One such life is Suleman.

After receiving a Bible, Suleman began reading it in the privacy of his home and was deeply moved by Christ's humility, love, forgiveness, and compassion.

Suleman made the decision to follow Jesus... a decision that cost him dearly.

When Suleman's family and friends learned of his faith, he was arrested. He spent six months in prison where he was tortured. His fingernails and toenails were pulled out. His personal business, an eyeglass shop, was destroyed.



Despite all, Suleman remained steadfast in Christ.

Today, he spends a lot of time studying the Bible with Pastor Amir and encouraging other new believers.

Such stories of Suleman and Shagufta (see attached letter) remind us why the ministry work in Pakistan is vital.

A letter can tell a suffering believer, "You are not forgotten."

A Bible placed into the hands of someone who has never heard the Good News can whisper, "You are forgiven. There is hope. Jesus loves you."

This vital ministry desperately needs our help to continue.

Sagufta Kiran - 41 year old Christian mother was arrested July 29, 2021 for blasphemy when she allegedly forwarded a WhatsApp message containing content critical of Islam. She was sentenced to death in September 2024 under Section 295-C of Pakistan's Penal Code.

Sister Shagufta Kiran is in a Pakistani prison for her Christian faith. As the Bible asks us, Door of Hope International works to help innocent believers.

A few weeks ago, one of our DOHI friends, Judy, wrote a letter to Shagufta, a Christian sister she had never met.

Judy's letter was simple but very important. She wrote:

"Dear Shagufta,

You are not forgotten. Christians in the free world know your name. We are praying for you!"

Judy didn't know if her letter would ever reach Shagufta inside Adiala Jail at the other end of the world. Then one day, the permission came for our ministry team to visit Shagufta, something we had been praying for.

The trip to the prison was long and arduous and the weather extremely hot. When the team finally arrived, they waited two anxious hours.

Judy's precious letter was hand delivered into the hands of this sister in chains.

Praise the Lord!

When Judy heard this, she wrote to us:

"Sister Shagufta has a special place in my heart as she was the first persecuted Christian that I took to my heart. So wonderful knowing she received the letters and confirmation of prayers from her brothers and sisters here in the free world. What good news and many blessings on the team that risked so much to visit Shagufta!"
